

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE SUPERVISORS OF HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP HELD
OCTOBER 27, 2016**

PRESENT: David Randler, Thomas Schoener, David Manbeck, Solicitor Haws, Carol Keppley, Robert Keppley, Chief Jeff Stone, David Kostival and Cheryl Bowers. **ABSENT –** Brian Thumm & Terry Wolfe.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Randler at 7:30 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

MINUTES: The minutes of the September 29, 2016 meeting were circulated. Supv. Schoener made a motion to approve the September 29, 2016 minutes, seconded by Supv. Manbeck and passed unanimously.

SPECIAL MEETING: The minutes of the Special Meeting of October 21, 2016 were circulated. Chairman Randler made a motion to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting of October 21, 2016, seconded by Supv. Schoener and passed unanimously.

TREASURERS REPORT: Treasurer Carol Keppley circulated the October treasurers report. Chairman Randler made a motion to approve the October treasurers report, seconded by Supv. Schoener and passed unanimously.

PAYMENT OF BILLS: Treasurer Carol Keppley presented the bills for payment. Supv. Manbeck made a motion to pay the bills as presented, seconded by Supv. Schoener and passed unanimously.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

SEWER – Chairman Randler reported everything has been completed at the pump station except the phone system which Jeff Shatz is working on. Chairman Randler reported on two quotes for baskets for the sewer pump. One is \$3,400 and the other one is \$3,800 – both with no rails. Chairman Randler said the quotes seem high – he will check with Glenn Eberly to see if he knows anyone that can do the work.

POLICE & FIRE – The report and schedule were circulated. Supv. Manbeck made a motion to approve the November schedule, seconded by Supv. Schoener and passed unanimously. Chief Stone will be using his own phone and the cost for service is \$40.00 a month. New tires were purchased for the cruiser. There is a grant available from MADD and Nationwide to purchase a breathalyzer. Chairman Randler made a motion to donate \$125.00 to Crime Alert to be matched by the DA's office, seconded by Supv. Schoener and passed unanimously.

PLANNING COMMISSION – No meeting in October.

ROADS, BLDG. & EQUIP. - The Road Report was circulated. Chairman Randler is working on the Big Spring Rd. bridge repair. Have not heard from Pennsy regarding Showers Rd. Supv. Manbeck asked Secretary to contact soccer club to see if they have practice on Election Day and if so they could park on the upper lot leaving spaces for voters and could they turn on the field lights till after polls close.

ZONING HEARING BOARD – Chairman Randler reported the Zoning Hearing Board approved the request from Justin Eberly to build a detached garage on his property.

ENGINEERS REPORT – TEI report emailed. Received Technicon Fee Schedule for 2017 – there will be no increase.


