POLICE & FIRE – No Police Report & Schedule. Supv. Thumm made a motion to hire Jeffrey T. Stone as the new Police Chief of Heidelberg Township, seconded by Supv. Schoener. Voting yes, Supvs. Thumm, Schoener, Wolfe, and Randler. Voting no – Supv. Manbeck. Motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS CONTINUED

ROADS, BLDG. & EQUIP. – Chairman Randler reported he met with the state’s bridge inspector regarding Big Spring Rd. The inspector said if we spend approximately \$20-\$25,000 now it could take us another 25 years until something more costly would have to be done. Estimates will be obtained for this year. Bunker Hill Rd. exit onto Bernville Rd. is still a problem. Motorists are going around the yellow markers. Chairman Randler reported that the Pioneer Hose is looking for a contribution for barricades. Supv. Thumm made a motion to donate \$100 to the Pioneer Hose for barricades, seconded by Supv. Schoener and passed unanimously. Also discussed was that someone is placing cones belonging to North Heidelberg Township on the roads. Supv. Manbeck said he would see that they are returned.

RECREATION BOARD – Supv. Wolfe stated he would like to see a pavilion and more trees planted by fall on the Ryeland Rd. property.

After some discussion it was decided to direct John Stine to send a letter notifying Mr. Nemeec how to correct the problem.

NORTH CHURCH STREET BRIDGE –Received info regarding a detour next June till September of 2017 for bridge work. He will keep us informed.


