

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE SUPERVISORS OF HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP HELD
JANUARY 28, 2016**

PRESENT: David Randler, David Manbeck, Thomas Schoener, Brian Thumm, Terry Wolfe, Carol Keppley, Robert Keppley, John Nace, Chief Boyer, Carolyn DeCenso, Anthony Tuccl, Val Lacin and Cheryl Bowers.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Randler at 7:30 PM with the Pledge to the flag.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

ANTHONY TUCCI – WESTERN BERKS AMBULANCE – Mr. Tucci presented the year end report for Heidelberg Township. There were a total of 216 calls. Which is 1.9% of all calls. They have approximately 12-13,000 calls for EMS and with transport brings the total close to 20,000 calls. Mr. Tucci thanked the Township for helping out during the recent snow storm and if they can do anything to just let them know.

MINUTES: The minutes of the December 17, 2015 were circulated. Supv. Thumm made a motion to approve the December 17, 2015 minutes, seconded by Supv. Schoener and passed unanimously.

REORGANIZATION MEETING MINUTES: The minutes of the reorganization meeting of January 4, 2016 were circulated. Supv. Thumm made a motion to approve the reorganization minutes of January 4, 2016, seconded by Supv. Manbeck and passed unanimously.

TREASURER REPORT – Treasurer Carol Keppley circulated the January treasurer's report. Supv. Thumm made a motion to approve the January treasurers report, seconded by Chairman Randler and passed unanimously.

PAYMENT OF BILLS – Treasurer Carol Keppley presented the bills for payment. Supv. Manbeck made a motion to pay the bills as presented, seconded by Supv. Schoener and passed unanimously.

Treasurer Carol Keppley reported that if payroll went to two times a month the payroll company would charge \$1,600 a year. We currently pay \$800 a year to the payroll company. Also, if we wanted direct deposit they would charge \$12.50 for one or 100 people. Larry is now receiving a min-month manual check as is Chief Boyer. All agreed to continue the way it has always been with one pay per month, except Chief Boyer and Larry Knoll and no direct deposit.

RECIND MOTION – **There was a motion made at the reorganization meeting to pay all employees two times a month starting in February. Supv. Thumm made a motion to rescind the motion made at the reorganization meeting, seconded by Supv. Manbeck and passed unanimously.**

COMMITTEE REPORTS

SEWER – Chairman Randler reported the auto dialer, generator and the wiring all have been completed.

POLICE & FIRE – The police report and schedule were circulated. Supv. Schoener made a motion to approve the police schedule, seconded by Supv. Manbeck and passed unanimously. Supv. Manbeck reported the air conditioner on the old police vehicle needs to be repaired come spring. Chief Boyer presented the Palm Road car count. Chairman Randler asked Chief Boyer to do the same thing on Big Spring Rd. from the school driveway to the bridge.

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COMMITTEE REPORTS CONTINUED

PLANNING COMMISSION – No report.

ROADS, BLDG. & EQUIP. - The road report was circulated. 2016-17 salt contract was tabled to determine how much salt is used in February. Road specs tabled. Chairman Randler said the '97 International truck (Gary's truck) broke down during the storm and will cost approximately \$7,000 to repair.

John Nace asked the Supervisors to purchase T- shirts (short and long sleeves) and jackets all in florescent color. He said it would provide safety for the road crew at all times. Supv. Manbeck made a motion to approve the purchase of florescent apparel for the road crew, seconded by Supv. Schoener and passed unanimously.

Discussion on purchasing a snow blower. Nothing was decided.

RECREATION BOARD – No report.

ZONING HEARING BOARD – No report.

BUILDING INSPECTORS REPORT – Supv. Thumm made a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION #4-2016** which adopts the 2016 Fee Schedule from CIA, seconded by Chairman Randler and passed unanimously.

PLUMBING & SEO – TEI report circulated.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

ACRE - Chairman Randler reported he attended the meeting of the Joint Planning Commission and the County will be paying for any revisions regarding ACRE. The Joint Planning Commission will meet again in April. David Wolfskill had expressed a zoning change for the old Wertz property.

CONRAD WEISER HOMESTEAD – Notification that they are applying to DEP for end wall repairs – no action needed.


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NEW BUSINESS CONTINUED
