

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE SUPERVISORS OF HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP HELD  
SEPTEMBER 24, 2015**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**MINUTES:** The minutes of the August 27, 2015 meeting were circulated. Supv. Wolfe made a motion to accept the minutes as circulated, seconded by Supv. Schoener and passed unanimously.

**TREASURERS REPORT:** Treasurer Carol Keppley circulated the September Treasurers report. Chairman Randler made a motion to approve the September treasurers report, seconded by Supv. Wolfe and passed unanimously.

**PAYMENT OF BILLS:** Treasurer Carol Keppley presented the bills for payment. There was a question on the amount of the Plasterer invoice. Supv. Schoener made a motion to pay the bills as presented, however the Treasurer will hold the Plasterer invoice until it is justified. Motion seconded by Supv. Bennick and passed unanimously.

SEWER – Select Environment September report circulated. Chairman Randler reported that Shatz Electric will have the work finished by next Friday.

POLICE & FIRE – The Police Report and Schedule were circulated. Chief Boyer reported he attended a meeting regarding the Jack Frost Parade which will be held on Sunday, Nov. 1 at 3 PM. This year they will be honoring all first responders. Trick or Treat will be Sat., Oct. 31 from 6 to 9 PM. Supv. Thumm stated Larry Ludwig will start on the 3-11 shift and will work 40 hrs. per week to start.

ROADS, BLDG. & EQUIP. – The Road Report was circulated. They road crew will be distributing recycling containers and checking the tree trimming.

Chairman Randler presented a quote from PSL Construction for a new roof over the front garages in the amount of \$6,427.14. This quote included the Township paying for materials and labor. Any plywood replacement will be extra. This quote is \$3,562.86 lower than the one from Flint Lane Construction. Chairman Randler made a motion to rescind the motion of the July 30 minutes awarding the bid to Flint Lane Construction as it was never executed by the Township. Motion seconded by Supv. Wolfe and passed unanimously.

Chairman Randler made a motion to authorize PSL Construction to proceed with the quote of \$6,427.14 for replacing the roof, seconded by Supv. Schoener and passed unanimously.


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**NEW BUSINESS CONTINUED**
